Extracurricular Participation Agreement (Sport)

Being a part of an extracurricular sports team is a privilege. Players are considered to be ambassadors of Sexsmith Secondary School and are expected to behave in accordance with this title.

The following are terms of this agreement:

Student Conduct

- *Each sporting event is recognized as a school function. All rules that apply to school events will also apply to sporting events.) Rules are presented in agenda books.
 - *Each member of the team is expected to ride with the team unless alternate plans have been made and approved by the principal or coach.
 - *During transportation to and from sporting event it is important to remember that bus drivers have ultimate authority over staff and students. This ensures the safety of both the players and coach.
 - *Each player is expected to display good sportsmanship at all times and to remember that he or she is a part of a team effort.
 - *It is also important to remember it is crucial to uphold a good academic standing or be considered to be working to potential.
 - *All athletes are expected to put in 100% effort to the team 100% of the time.
 - *All participants are to treat coaches, advisors, officials, other teams and equipment with respect.
 - *All participants are expected to be punctual for all events.
- Win or lose, always do it with class! Sportsmanship above all else!

Consequences

- infraction 1– sit out of 1 quarter of a game
- infraction 2– half game suspension
- infraction 3– full game suspension
- infraction 4- removal from the team
